DECISION APPROVING SETTLEMENT

Before: Judge Fauver

This is an action for back pay, based upon an alleged act of discrimination under 105(d) of the Federal Mine Safety and Health Act of 1977, 30 U.S.C. 801 et seq.

The parties have moved the judge to approve a settlement agreement in which the miners named in the settlement shall be paid the back pay agreed to.

I have considered the reasons and documentation submitted and I conclude that the proposed settlement is consistent with the purpose of 105(c) of the Act. Accordingly, the settlement is approved.

ORDER

1. The motion to approve a settlement is GRANTED.
2. The parties shall promptly comply with all of the terms of the settlement.
3. Based upon the above, this proceeding is DISMISSED.
