The Commission will consider and act upon the following in open session: *Secretary of Labor v. Nelson Quarries, Inc.*, Docket Nos. CENT 2006-151-M, CENT 2006-203-M, and CENT 2006-201-M. (Issues include whether the Administrative Law Judge properly concluded that certain individuals were agents of the operator and therefore their negligence was imputable to the operator for unwarrantable failure and penalty assessment purposes, that the operator's violation of 30 C.F.R. § 56.6130(a) was significant and substantial, and that the operator violated 30 C.F.R. § 56.6300(b).)
