(Issues include whether the Administrative Law Judge erred when he granted the Secretary of Labor's motion for summary decision and found that the operator violated the requirement of 30 C.F.R. § 56.14211(c) that a raised component of mobile equipment must be secured to prevent accidental lowering when persons working on or around the equipment are exposed to the hazard of accidental lowering of the component).
